	-Naloxone training held for Library staff; approval received for kits to be kept behind Service desk – reminder to follow safety protocol. Lynne will pick up kits and distribute. -Fire alarms triggered by vaping in Library bathrooms - numbers not available through Security as they are not able to determine cause of fire alarms. Could Library staff track alarms and note when vaping is the cause? Creates an opportunity to communicate repercussions, consequences to students. -Campus Snow Plan – reporting tool shared, QR code, signs posted in parking lots. 90+ salt bins located across campus – all are encouraged to use when necessary. -The Working Mind – Health Safety & Wellness – programs and workshops available online. Reminder to encourage and share content on Wellness page. -Summary of incidents report: Hospitality services and Athletics & Rec. Overall incidents mainly include cuts & lacerations (art studio & labs). Incident in Mills Library, 5th Floor – Facility staff member poked by sharp while dusting stacks – noted that Library was not notified of incident in advance. Alicia will ensure communication with Library for future incidents. -Discussion around fire inspections not being complete – extinguishers in Library are checked with floor inspections.
